RE: South Carolina Industry-Wide Petroleum Waivers

Dear South Carolina Petroleum Industry Representatives,

Because of Hurricane Harvey and Irma, the South Carolina Department of Agriculture is issuing waivers to help eliminate potential supply issues. There should be no impact or effect on quality of fuel due to this waiver.

South Carolina gasoline specifications for September 7-October 31, 2017:

- The South Carolina Department of Agriculture will waive the 9.0 RVP requirement through October 31, 2017 permitting the distribution of 11.5 RVP fuel.
- The South Carolina Department of Agriculture will allow the co-mingling of RFG with conventional fuel.
- The South Carolina Department of agriculture will waive Butane Blending requirements for gasoline through October 31, 2017 to allow delivery of petroleum products from other states into South Carolina destinations
- The South Carolina Department of Agriculture will waive the T V/L = 20 specification for the period of September 7, 2017 through October 31, 2017.
